The conference venue is the 3 star Falmouth Hotel, Castle Beach, Falmouth, Cornwall, TR11 4NZ. The hotel is set in 5 acres of attractive landscaped gardens and has a prime sea front location. Guests can enjoy some wonderful views over Pendennis Castle and the impressive natural harbour and great sea views from the hotel. This Richardson group hotel is a great venue to meet.

Free car parking is available at the hotel. The nearest mainline train stations is Falmouth Docks operated by Great Western Rail. Taxis should be available at the stations (about 2 minute taxi drive) or it is a 5min walk from the station to the Hotel.


